Dennis Korth, Sioux Falls, SD, died September 8, 2005, in Sioux Falls. He was 47.

Dennis Ray Korth was born on January 18, 1958, to Vern and Esther (Meyer) Korth. He attended grade school at Rainy Buttes one-room school and New England, ND. He moved with his family several times in his teenage years. He graduated from Bismarck High School in 1977. Dennis joined the US Army in 1980. Serving for three years, he was stationed at Schweinfurt, Germany most of that time.

He moved to Rapid City, SD and then to Sturgis. He eventually ended up working for Lowe Roofing in Whitewood, SD, where he worked for nine years. During that time he met his wife, Katie (Kathryn Jedrykowski-Mahoney).

He also loved the Black Hills for the camping, fishing, hiking and enjoyed the general beauty of the hills. He will be missed by his three Shelties, which he walked and played fetch with daily.
